The Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia in Copenhagen presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Lithuania, all Diplomatic Missions and International Organizations resident in Lithuania, and has the honour to inform the latter that the Government of the Republic of Indonesia has established 75 (seventy five) countries and region exempted from requirement to obtain a visa to enter Indonesia for tourism purposes for a period of 30 (thirty) days without having a visa, through *the Presidential Regulation of the Republic of Indonesia Number 104, 2015 on amendment of the Presidential Regulation of the Republic of Indonesia Number 69, 2015 regarding Visit Visa Exemption.*

The Presidential Regulation of the Republic of Indonesia No. 104, 2015 come into force on 23 September 2015. The Visa Free Visit cannot be extended or converted into any other permit. The list of the countries and the certain Immigration Check-Points are attached herewith.

The Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia in Copenhagen avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Lithuania, all Diplomatic Missions and International Organizations resident in Lithuania the assurances of its highest consideration.
